## CERTIFICATION


- ◆ Certification is a badge that identifies teachers as a distinguished select group of individuals whom families entrust their children and youth. (K-12 Educators Certification Manual, page 2)
- ✓ Evidence that teachers have prepared themselves to do this special work
- ✓ Adventist educators are expected to earn and maintain certification
- ✓ Certification allows a teacher to "teach"

- ❖NAD Office of Education has designed the:
  - Procedures for acquiring certification
  - Policies for keeping certification current
  - Certification types:
    - ✓ Basic
    - √ Standard
    - ✓ Professional
    - ✓ Administrative
    - ✓ Conditional
    - ✓ Designated





## GENERAL ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

## K-12 Educators Certification Manual, pages 7-8

- 1. Conferences verify that teachers are members of a Seventh-day Adventist Church
- 2. Conferences verify that teachers exhibit ethical and moral conduct
- 3. Have a bachelor's degree from an accredited college/university

### **General certificate Requirements included:**

Complete 20 - semester hours of professional education courses:

- Principles and Philosophy of Adventist Education
- ✓ Developmental Psychology
- ✓ Educational Psychology
- ✓ Educational Assessment
- Exceptional Child in the Classroom
- ✓ Elementary or Secondary Student Teaching
- ✓ Elementary or Secondary Content Area Endorsement
- ✓ Complete a course in Integrating Technology in the Classroom



## Basic Teaching Certificate

## K-12 Educators Certification Manual, pages 10 – 12

- Valid for 3-years of teaching within a 5-year period from certificate issue date and/or when certification requirements were met
- ❖ Meet the General Eligibility Requirements

### **General Basic Teaching Certificate Requirements**

- 1A. Issued a Verification of Eligibility Certificate from an NAD Approved Program
- **1B**. Complete a Credit-based Program consisting of:
- ✓ 12 Academic Semester hours of Bible Courses from an accredited SDA College/University
- ✓ Health Education Bible-based with E.G. White's Writings
- ✓ 20 Academic Semester Hours of Professional Education Courses
- 2. Qualify for Elementary or Secondary Content Area Endorsement



## Basic Teaching Certificate

## K-12 Educators Certification Manual, pages 10 – 12

### **Renewal Requirements**

- ❖ If you <u>have not</u> completed 3-years of full-time teaching experience by end of your 3<sup>rd</sup> year of certification
  - ✓ Send a request for a 1 or 2 year extension to the Southern Union Registrar in writing (mail or email)
- If you <u>have not</u> completed 3-years of full-time teaching or 5-years of part-time teaching experience by end of your 5<sup>th</sup> year of certification
  - ✓ Complete 6 academic semester hours to renew your certificate for 2 years
  - ✓ Submit an official academic transcript for credits earned to the Southern Union Registrar's office
  - ✓ All courses must be completed within the most recent five (5) years

### **Reinstatement Requirements**

- ❖ If you <u>have not</u> completed 3-years of full-time teaching or 5-years of part-time teaching experience and your certificate has been expired
  - ✓ 2 or more Complete 6 academic semester hours of Professional education courses or courses in area(s) of endorsement
  - ✓ Submit an official academic transcript for credits earned to the Southern Union Registrar's office
  - ✓ All courses must be completed within the most recent five (5) years

## K-12 Educators Certification Manual, pages 12 – 14

- ❖ Valid for 5-years from the certificate issue date
- Meet the General Eligibility Requirements



### **Standard Teaching Certificate General Requirements**

- 1. Basic Teaching Certificate requirements met
- A minimum of 3-years of full-time teaching or 5-years of part-time teaching experience completed in a K-12 classroom
- 3. Six (6) academic semester hours of Professional Education Courses completed
  - ✓ In areas of endorsements **beyond** the requirements of the Basic certificate
  - ✓ Submit an official academic transcript for credits earned to the Southern Union Registrar's office
- 4. Basic certificate endorsements transfer to the Standard Certificate

## K-12 Educators Certification Manual, pages 12 – 14

## **Renewal Requirements**

Complete a total of ten (10) semester hours



- 1. A minimum of Four (4) academic semester hours
  - ✓ Upper division/post-baccalaureate or graduate credit
  - ✓ Submit an official academic transcript for credits earned to the Southern Union Registrar's office
  - ✓ Specific requirements established by the union/conference in which the educator is currently employed at the time of renewal
  - ✓ All courses must be completed within the most recent five (5) years of your current certification
- 2. A maximum of Six (6) semester hours of Professional Activity CEUs (180 clock hours)
  - ✓ PAC Activity Form Dates: August 1 to July 31 of each year
  - ✓ PAC Forms are due <u>August 1</u> in the Conference Office each year <u>or</u> an earlier date set by the Local Conference Office of Education

#### Renewal Requirements – CONT.

- Standard Teaching Certificate with an Elementary endorsement
- ✓ Complete at least <u>two (2) courses</u> in the following areas:
  - Advanced Instructional Technology Applications
  - Applied Arts Methods
  - Children's Literature
  - Fine Arts Methods
  - Multicultural Education
  - Outdoor Education
  - Physical Education Methods
  - ☐ Teaching English Language Learners
- Standard Teaching Certificate with a secondary endorsement
- ✓ Complete at least one (1) course in the following areas:
  - Advanced Instructional Technology Applications
  - Multicultural Education
  - Learning Theory/Style
  - ☐ Teaching English Language Learners (ELL)
  - Theories of Teaching and Learning



## K-12 Educators Certification Manual, pages 12 – 14

### Reinstatement Requirements - Certificate expired 2 or more years

- The following criteria must be met:
- 1. Current requirements for the Standard Teaching Certificate
- 2. Ten (10) academic semester hours of upper division/post-baccalaureate or graduate credit:
  - ✓ Professional education courses or courses in area(s) of endorsement
  - ✓ Submit an official academic transcript for credits earned to the Southern Union Registrar's office
  - ✓ All courses must be completed within the most recent five (5) years



## Professional Teaching Certificate

## K-12 Educators Certification Manual, pages 14 – 16

- Valid for 5-years from the certificate issue date
- Meet the General Eligibility Requirements

#### **General Requirements**

- 1. Qualify for a Standard Teaching Certificate
- 2. Meets <u>one</u> of the following requirements:
- ✓ Hold a Master's Degree (to move from Basic to Professional see special requirements in manual) OR
- ✓ Completed a fifth-year teachers program OR
- ✓ Earned 40 semester hours of upper-division/post-baccalaureate or graduate credit
  - 30 semester hours in professional education courses and/or no more than 2 endorsement areas
- 3. Earned upper-division/post-baccalaureate, or graduate credit **beyond** the Basic Teaching Certificate requirements in at least **two** of the following areas:
  - Advanced Instructional Practice
  - Advanced Instructional Technology Applications
  - Classroom Assessment Strategies
  - Curriculum
  - Inclusive and/or Special Education
  - Multicultural Education
  - Teaching English Language Learners (ELL)
  - Theories of Teaching and Learning
  - Trends and Issues in Education



## Professional Teaching Certificate

### K-12 Educators Certification Manual, pages 14 – 16

### **Renewal Requirements**

- Six (6) semester hours in <u>any combination</u> of the following:
- 1. Academic upper division/post-baccalaureate or graduate credit
  - ✓ Professional education courses or courses in area(s) of endorsement
  - ✓ Submit an official academic transcript for credits earned to the Southern Union Registrar's office
  - ✓ All courses must be completed within the most recent five (5) years of your current certification
- 2. Professional Activity CEUs (30 clock hours = 1 semester hour)
  - ✓ PAC Activity Form Dates: August 1 to July 31 of each year school year
  - ✓ PAC Forms are due <u>August 1</u> in the Conference Office each year <u>or</u> an earlier date set by the Local Conference Office of Education

### Reinstatement Requirements - Certificate expired two (2) or more years

- 1. Current requirements for the Professional Teaching Certificate
- 2. Six (6) semester hours:
- ✓ <u>Minimum</u> of 3 academic semester hours of upper division/post-baccalaureate or graduate credit in professional education or endorsement area
- ✓ <u>Maximum</u> of 3 semester hours of Professional Activity CEUs (90 clock hours = 3 semester hours)
- ✓ All courses must be completed within the most recent five (5) years



## Administrator Teaching Certificate

### K-12 Educators Certification Manual, pages 16 – 17

- Valid for five (5) years from the certificate issue date
- Met General Eligibility Requirements



### **General Requirements**

- 1. Qualifies for a Professional Teaching Certificate
- 2. Holds a Master's Degree
- 3. Complete a minimum of 18 academic semester hours of graduate courses from these areas:
  - ✓ Curriculum Development
  - School Administration
  - ✓ Supervision of Instruction
  - ✓ School Law
  - ✓ School Finance
  - ✓ School Facilities
  - ✓ Personnel Administration
  - ✓ School Public Relations
  - ✓ Religious Education
  - ✓ Field Experience
- 4. Qualify for at least one of the Administrator Endorsement (page 29)
- OR Hold a doctorate degree in Administration and/or Leadership with Emphasis in Education

## Administrator Teaching Certificate

### K-12 Educators Certification Manual, pages 16 – 17

### **Renewal Requirements**

- Six (6) semester hours in **any combination** of the following:
- 1. Academic upper division/post-baccalaureate or graduate credit
  - Professional education courses or courses in area(s) of endorsement
  - ✓ Submit an official academic transcript for credits earned to the Southern Union Registrar's office
  - ✓ All course must be completed within the most recent five (5) years of your current certification
- Professional Activity CEUs (30 clock hours = 1 semester hour)
  - ✓ PAC Activity Form Dates: August 1 to July 31 of each year school year
  - ✓ PAC Forms are due <u>August 1</u> in the Conference Office each year <u>or</u> an earlier date set by the Local Conference Office of Education

### Reinstatement Requirements - Certificate expired two (2) or more years

- 1. Current requirements for the Professional Teaching Certificate
- 2. Six (6) semester hours:
- Minimum of 3 academic semester hours of upper division/post-baccalaureate or graduate credit in professional education or endorsement area
- ✓ <u>Maximum</u> of 3 semester hours of Professional Activity CEUs (90 clock hours = 3 semester hours)
- Credit in integrating educational technology in the classroom (see Section 1.5.1)
- All course must be completed within the most recent five (5) years



## DESIGNATED SERVICES/SUBJECTS CERTIFICATE

## K-12 Educators Certification Manual, pages 18 – 19

- Valid for 1 3 years from the certificate issued date
- Issued to an individual who has <u>demonstrated expertise</u> in specific <u>non-core subject areas</u>
- This certificate cannot be substituted for the Basic, Standard, or Professional Teaching Certificate, or used in a way to circumvent the meeting of the requirements for those certificates.

#### **General Requirements**

- 1. Recommended by your Superintendent (Designated Application)
- 2. Meets NAD General Eligibility Requirements
- Hass at least a high school diploma and the qualifying paid work experience (see page 19 chart details)
- Provide a <u>resume</u> with <u>paid work experience</u> in the <u>non-core subject area</u> (technical skill, trade, vocation, or non-vocational)
- 5. At least one year of paid work experience must be in the most recent 3-years

#### **Renewal Requirements**

- Renewal requirements are listed on the Designated Application by the Superintendent/Principal
  - Specific Professional <u>Activities</u> CEUs and/or <u>academic credits</u> that improves pedagogy or subject area expertise must be listed on the DS Application
  - Specific Professional Activities CEUs and/or academic credits hours must be listed on DS Application

## Conditional Teaching Certificate

### K-12 Educators Certification Manual, pages 20

- Valid for 1 years from the certificate issue date
- Met General Eligibility Requirements
  - SDA Church Member
  - Exhibit Ethical & Moral Conduct
  - Bachelor's Degree from an Accredited College/University
- Conditional Teaching Certificate are issued to applicants who
  - do not meet the requirements of a Basic Teaching Certificate
  - > are working towards regular Standard or Professional certification and/or an endorsement
  - are working on reinstatement of a Standard or Professional certificates (1-year only)

#### **General Requirements**

- Must hold at least a Bachelor's Degree
- 2. Must be working toward a Basic, Standard, or Professional Teaching Certificate

#### **Renewal Requirements**

- 1. Complete at least 6 academic semester credit hours each year until all Needs List requirements are completed
- 2. A minimum of one course in religion must be completed or a competency exam passed each contract year until all religion requirements are met



## Renewal Activity

### **Continuing Education Units Form:**

- Continuing Education/Non-academic credit work only
- Include date and a clear description of the activity
- Include a copy of certificates (if given)
- Teachers submit forms the Conference office by August 1 or sooner
- Conferences submit forms to the Certification Office by August 15 or sooner
  - Forms should be reviewed and signed by the Superintendent or a designated person
  - Late forms will not be accepted

#### **Academic Courses:**

- Challenge Exams Andrews University
- Southern Union Requirements
  - Trends & Issues in Education w/4MAT (Oakwood University and Southern Adventist University)
    - 4MAT 690 or 4MAT On-The-Go (Online Options through <u>About Learning</u>)
- Conference Requirements
- Teachers must request official transcripts be to the Certification Office
- Certification changes are not made without official transcripts







## Certification Forms

### Southern Union Application for Certification

- The following teachers must complete a Southern Union Conference (SUC) Application for Certification:
  - Newly hired teachers who never taught in a Southern Union school (from public schools, other unions, etc.)
  - Former teachers with NAD certification who are returning to teach in a Southern Union school (from public schools, other unions, leave of absence, retirement, etc.)
  - New and/or Former teachers with NAD certification who live in the SUC and want to maintain their certification but are not teaching in a Southern Union school (retirees, public school teachers, on a leave of absence, etc.)

### **Continuing Education Units Form**

- Due in your conference office every year by <u>August 1</u>
  - Period covered is 8/1 to 7/31 of the <u>current</u> school year to be applied to certification for the <u>following</u> school year

### **Designated Subject/Service Application**

- Complete the entire Application including the name of the non-core subject to be taught
- Include a current resume highlighting paid work experience in the non-core subject area
- Complete the Renewal Requirement section with academic and/or non-academic activities to be completed for growth as well as the number of hours

- SUC Bible Methods Course Outline for Elementary/Secondary

## Data Roll Up

#### <u>Critical Errors Report - Dashboard</u>

- Make sure your school does not have any errors
- For assistance with correcting errors, contact your conference office
- Resolve errors ASAP

### Opening Report Data

- Make sure your teachers, students, grades, etc. are listed correctly
- Data freezes three (3) weeks after school opens by NAD
- Incorrect information will affect your enrollment accuracy

### **Closing Report Data**

- Make sure you are closing your school data in a timely manner
- Data will freeze three (3) weeks after school closes by NAD
- Incorrect information will affect your enrollment accuracy

- Legal First and Last Name
- Educator ID#
- Full-time
- Part-time
- Local Funded
- Volunteers

## **Full-time Teaching Verification**

- The verification comes from the Superintendent's Office to the Registrar's Office
- Superintendent's office sends verification that a teacher has successfully completed three-years of fulltime teaching or 5-years of part-time teaching
  - This will remove the requirement for the teachers Needs List

## Student Teaching Waiver

- The request comes from the Superintendent's Office to the Registrar's Office
- A request to waive Student Teaching is based on:
  - The teacher did not complete student teaching at an accredited college/university AND
  - The teacher has successfully taught full-time for at least three years in a K-12 system
