

SUMMER 2019 - STEPS FOR SOUTHERN UNION TEACHERS

- Visit http://www.southern.edu/adventistcertification to review Summer 2019 course offerings and begin your Summer 2019 Adventist Teacher Application. A new Adventist Teacher Application is required from ALL students each year. The new academic year begins in May each Summer.
- 2. Once you have filled out the information requested on the "Start an Adventist Teacher Application" page, you should receive a confirmation email from Southern Graduate Studies with instructions for completing your application.
- 3. Once your application has been completed and submitted by you and processed by Graduate Studies, you will receive a confirmation email from Southern Graduate Studies. It will include your Southern ID number and instructions for setting up a Southern login/password if you do not already have one. Instructions for setting up a Southern email account and for online registration will be sent to the email you provide on your Adventist Teacher Application, so please be sure to check it and follow through with all the required steps.
- 4. Once notified by Southern, complete registration online. In order to complete registration *all students* are required to complete a Financial Responsibility Agreement (FRA) online via their Southern account. You may access the form by going to www.southern.edu and clicking "My Access" in the top right corner of the main page. As prompted, login using the Southern username and password that you have set up. Once the My Access dashboard loads, click Academics and select "Enrollment Checklist" from the pull-down menu. You should see a symbol with "Financial Responsibility Agreement" next to it. Please click the link to complete and submit the form online, as registration cannot be finalized until it is submitted. Registration can be completed by clicking Academics and Register for Courses. PLEASE NOTE: ALL SUMMER EDUCATION COURSES ARE LISTED IN THE "SUMMER 2019 SESSION 2" TERM, AND NOT IN THE "SUMMER 2019" TERM.
- 5. If taking on-campus classes and need housing, reservations are required. Contact Mrs. Lisa Patterson at 423.236.2990 for pricing information and to make reservations. Payment is required upon arrival, and any arrangements for reimbursement must be made directly with your Conference Education Office.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

- **FOOD**: Students are responsible for all costs/charges. For information regarding options, hours of operation & daily/weekly menus, visit https://www.southern.edu/administration/food/index.html.
- BOOKS & SUPPLIES: Students are responsible for all costs/charges. Textbooks are available at the Campus Shop, the bookstore
 on campus. Call 423.236.2152 or visit https://www.saucampusshop.com (Textbook Lookup) for costs, availability, and shipping
 information. You may also elect to purchase textbooks from a vendor such as Amazon. Once you are registered, you may
 access your Book List by logging in to Access (see Item 4 above), clicking Academics, and selecting Book List from the pull-down
 menu.
- VEHICLE REGISTRATION: Students are responsible for all costs/charges. All vehicles on-campus must be registered with Campus Safety. If your stay is 2 weeks or less, visit Campus Safety to obtain a free temporary parking pass. For longer than 2 weeks, go to http://campussafety.southern.edu and click the "Vehicle Info" in the sidebar menu on the right side of the page. Click "Vehicle Parking and Registration" to obtain a permit. Summer parking permits cost \$15.00, which will need to be paid by credit/debit card; this cannot be charged to your student ID account. To complete vehicle registration, students must have an SAU ID card/number. Contact Campus Safety at 423.236.2100 during regular business hours for assistance.
- TRANSCRIPT REQUESTS: No transcripts will be sent to your conference or the Union Office automatically. Your student account must be paid in full and you must complete a transcript request form online to have a transcript of your grades sent anywhere outside of Southern Adventist University.
 - 1. Go to http://www.southern.edu/records.
 - 2. Click "Transcripts" in the sidebar menu on the right side of the page.
 - 3. Carefully read and follow the instructions for Former Students.
 - 4. A nominal fee will apply credit or debit card required.
