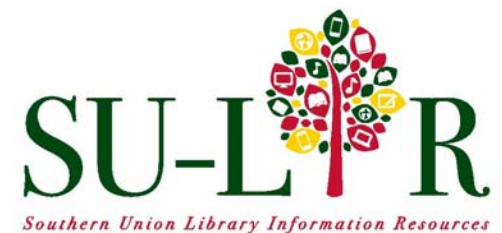

Mandarin M5 allows access to library resources on any computer with an internet connection. The simple interface is easy to learn, and the appearance and features have been tailored for each SU-LIR program participating school. Library managers can e-circulate materials and patrons can e-search materials in their collection. Cataloging and inventorying library materials is made simple with Mandarin Library Automation.

OMS**

Mackin.com is an educational resource provider—one of many vendors used by the SU-LIR Program. For more than 30 years, Mackin has worked with over 18,000 publishers to provide library and classroom materials for grades PreK-12. It's 3 main functions are: to provide information about the products and services offered by Mackin; To host the online management systems (OMS); and as a marketplace to shop for library resources.

**Help.Mackin.com** is the online helpdesk, which houses tutorials for using Mackin.com and MackinVIA in both video and written format.



**SU-LIR Library Funds**
