Assessment Instructions

Photocopy this template for each child at the beginning of the school year. In the month of August, have each child draw a picture that represents him/her-self, a family member, or other person (ex. Bible character, friend, relative, etc.). Repeat this activity at the end of each quarter (Oct, Dec, Mar, and May). Always place the finished portrait drawing in the child's respective Work Samples portfolio. The growing collection for each child should show his/her developmental progress throughout the school year.

If preferred, or simply for the fun of variety, allowing the children to draw portraits on a chalkboard or whiteboard and taking close-up photos of the portrait drawings, printing them and keeping them in their portfolios is also good.

These quarterly portraits will assist the teacher in tracking the developmental progress of each child.
