WrAP Testing

The Writing Assessment Program (WrAP) is administered once a year in the spring across five grade-level bands to allow students to show increased proficiency at each level. Students' proficiency success depends greatly on the quality and consistency of writing instruction and is the direct result of students' access to: ample time to write, timely and effective feedback, and efficient models to support the most important work of writing. With best instructional practices, students will develop a love of writing and the skills necessary for college and the world of work and career, and for pleasure. The Writing Assessment Program (WrAP) works with any curriculum that is grounded in best practices of teaching and learning writing. The WrAP comes with Wriit, a companion library of instructional tools and resources for member teachers and their students. During the pandemic, there is an option for at home administration of the WrAP.

The WrAP test is administered in the following grade-level bands:

Elementary Grades 3 - 4: Non-Stimulus Based/ Narrative Prompt

Intermediate Grades 5-6: Stimulus-Based /Informational Prompt

Middle Grades 7-8: Stimulus-Based / Opinion/Argument Prompt
