


**Book 4 – Arbor Day Square**

First grade students were introduced to DOL procedures in Theme 4 (Spiritual Journey/*Giving Gifts*). Teachers should provide explicit instruction, scaffolding, and direction until 1<sup>st</sup> grade students are accustomed to the editing process.
