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Mandarin Library Automation (M5)

Mandarin M5 allows access to library resources on any device with an internet connection. Library managers can electronically circulate (check-out/-in) materials, send email notifications for overdue materials and fines and also catalog and inventory books, textbooks, and equipment with M5. Patrons can search for materials in their school's collection from anywhere.

Mackin.com for OMS

MACKIN is an educational resource provider— one of many vendors used by the SU-LIR program. For more than 30 years, Mackin has worked with over 18,000 publishers to provide library and classroom materials for grades Pk-12 . It's three main functions are: 1) to provide information about the products and services offered by Mackin; 2) as a marketplace to shop for library resources; 3) to host the online management system (OMS)

MACKIN VIA is the portal used to access a school's digital resources, i. e. databases and e-books.

HELP.MACKIN.COM is the online helpdesk, which houses tutorials for using Mackin and MackinVIA in both video written format.

SU-LIR LIBRARY FUNDS
